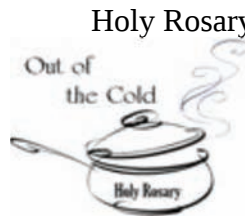
C.W.L. MEMBERSHIP DRIVE – January 27/28
