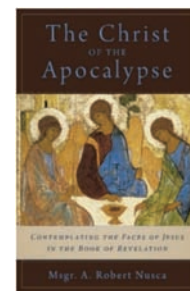

Holy Rosary Church Building Committee - Report to Parishioners

Having talked for so long about the major repairs needed at Holy Rosary, many of you may have been wondering what is happening. We now have an excellent Building Committee, including two architects (Anne-Marie Fleming and Diane Grannum), a landscape architect (Michael Toccalino), our Parish Accountant (Cathy Carroll), Msgr. Nusca, and Alex Makuz (accountant) and Jeremy Gawen (engineer) as co-chairs.

It has taken us a while, but we have finally selected a heritage architectural firm (ERA) with long experience in dealing with older buildings such as ours, to supervise the work. They have already begun making a detailed assessment of each of the areas of concern.

The priority is to get the area directly in front of the main entrance of the church, including the steps, rebuilt; we hope to do this work this Fall. Next on the list are the windows in the south-west corner of the Parish Hall whose frames are badly rusted. We will also be refinishing and repairing the church doors. In the next week or two you may see people up inspecting the church roof and the exterior stonework. We will then get a detailed report of the work needed in these areas and the recommended timing and cost.

We will keep you posted as things progress.

Be sure, we will be spending your money wisely!
