


The Building Committee and Jeff Hayes from ERA, the architects supervising the renovations at Holy Rosary, have been busy and you will start to see some tangible results:

- We have let the contract to repair the **platform and steps at the St Clair entry to the church.** The
 work is expected to begin in November and take up
 to four weeks. During that period, you will need to
 use the side entrances to the church as we will have
 to close off the front entrance. We will provide
 more detail as we progress.
 - You will see scaffolding installed on either side of the church like. This is to allow access to the **roof** and the stonework for Jeff to carry out a detailed inspection of both. Once that is done, we will be in a position to plan the repairs needed. Repair work will not start until next year at the earliest because both require good weather.
 - We have had a consultant in to take a look at the **church lighting** because a number of you have mentioned that the church is not well lit. We have a beautiful church, but it is difficult at times to see it because of the poor lighting. Don't worry, we are not planning to change the beautiful old fixtures which were installed when the church was built, just get more light out of them!

We will keep you posted as we progress with the work.
