

We are using multiple small teams of volunteers for their protection and are fortunate to have several university students assisting us.

Maple Leaf Entertainment has for the past few months been providing us with 1500 prepared meals per week for our clients which we shared with several other smaller programs that would not normally be able to receive the meals. This has been a tremendous assistance to us.
