

HOLY ROSARY BUILDING COMMITTEE FALL 2021 UPDATE

The Holy Rosary Building Committee is pleased to report that nearly all the major renovation work on the church and hall exteriors is now complete. The copper roof on the church has been largely replaced and all the stonework repointed. The church doors have been refinished and the heating units in both church and hall, replaced; the new hall roof has just been completed and work is well underway to secure the windows on the east side of the hall from a safety standpoint.

In addition, we have had to do a significant repair on the rectory wastewater drainpipes and will shortly repair the exterior drains at the back of the church. You will note that the church has been cleaned from top to bottom. We have also let a small contract to tidy up the landscaping around the grounds of the church, cutting overgrown trees/bushes back and re-planting the bed in front of the church.

Shortly, thanks to a generous bequest from a parishioner, we will be moving the Tabernacle from the side chapel to the centre of the sanctuary where the statue of Christ the King is currently located, cleaning and refinishing the wood paneling and highlighting the beautiful inscriptions around the top of the paneling. Finally, we believe it will now be possible to replace the existing lighting fixtures in the church with identical pendants but using the latest LED technology. This, coupled with much improved sanctuary lighting, will allow everyone to see our beautiful church in all its glory. We are very grateful to two parishioners who have made significant bequests to assist us in partially funding

significant bequests to assist us in partially funding this project. We will be starting a campaign shortly to raise the rest of the money required.
