The Pastor's Reflection

"He was amazed at their lack of faith." (Mk 6:6)

Dear brothers and sisters in Christ:

There are only two recorded instances in the Gospels where Jesus is said to have been "amazed". The first takes place when the pagan centurion believes that Jesus's words would suffice for a miracle to happen (cf. Mt 8:5-13). Matthew writes, "When Jesus heard this, he was amazed and said to those who follow him, "Truly I tell you, I have not found anyone in Israel with such great faith." (Mt 8:10). The second instance comes from today's Gospel. Mark tells us that Jesus was "not able to perform any mighty deed there, apart from curing a few sick people by laying his hands on them. He was amazed at their lack of faith." (Mk 6:5-6)

The surprise comes from the fact that those who lack faith sometimes do have faith, and those who are supposed to have strong faith sometimes have very little. Years ago, I remember meeting a Catholic woman, who was very upset over the fact that her non-believing husband had demonstrated more trust in God in the midst of a tragedy than she did. She was the one who went to Mass each week and prayed the rosary daily. She felt that it was unfair.

Today's Gospel and the example of the Catholic woman remind us of the need to continually ask God for this precious gift that comes from him alone. We can never have too much faith, but we can certainly have too little. Let us invite and allow God to amaze us each day. Let us pray that if Jesus returns in our lifetime, he will find faith in our hearts and in our actions (cf. Lk 18:8).
