The Pastor's Reflection

"Ephphatha!" that is, "Be opened"- And immediately the man's ears were opened, his speech impediment was removed, and he spoke plainly." (Mk

7:33-4)

Dear brothers and sisters in Christ:

Towards the end of the baptismal liturgy, the priest makes the sign of the cross over the ears and mouth of the child while pronouncing the following prayer: "The Lord Jesus made the deaf hear and the dumb speak. May he soon touch your ears to receive his word, and your mouth to proclaim his faith, to the praise and glory of God the Father."

This beautiful prayer was inspired by today's Gospel. Before his healing, the man was deaf and had a speech impediment. Since he was unable to hear, he was unable to understand what people were saying to him. Worse, he could not hear the words of the Old Testament being proclaimed in the synagogue. This impediment also affected his ability to speak to others. He must have suffered terribly.

Jesus senses the man's pain and heals him. He does it by placing spittle in the ears of the man. In the ancient world, spittle was believed to contain healing properties. While it is Jesus who heals the man, he must offer treatment that is understandable to the man and to others. Now, the man hears and listens to what Jesus has to say, and he can speak about what he hears to others. And boy does he ever! He went to tell everyone he could find.

We are called to do the same. Baptism makes us missionaries. We are called to listen attentively to God each day in the reading of the Sacred Scriptures and to speak about him with others. There is so much fear mongering in our world today due to some duplicitous politicians and other public figures. We have reason for hope: God's word tells us. "be strong, fear not!...God comes to save you!" (Is 35: 4). Let us spend time each day reading the bible. Living With Christ publishes the daily Mass readings and it is a free app you can download on your phone. You and your family and friends will all benefit from sharing words of encouragement spoken by God's own mouth.


