### The Pastor's Reflection

"For the Son of Man did not come to be served but to serve and to give his life as a ransom for many." (Mk 10:45)

Dear brothers and sisters in Christ:

Happy World Mission Sunday! Today, the universal Church reminds us that we are all called to share our faith in Christ with the whole world. The Second Vatican Council published an important decree entitled "Ad Gentes." To quote, "The mission of the Church, therefore, is fulfilled by that activity which makes her, obeying the command of Christ and influenced by the grace and love of the Holy Spirit, fully present to all men or nations, in order that, by the example of her life and by her preaching, by the sacraments and other means of grace, she may lead them to the faith, the freedom and the peace of Christ; that thus there may lie open before them a firm and free road to full participation in the mystery of Christ." (AG 5)

How does faith in the crucified Jesus bring freedom and peace to people? By "giving his life as an offering for sin" he wins for us reconciliation with the Father (Is 53:10). Humanity was estranged from God until his Son came in the flesh to redeem all that was lost. No matter what our ancestors tried to do, they were unable to save themselves. The gate of heaven was tightly closed until Jesus mounted the wood of the cross. When someone discovers this incredible love story between God and humanity, we are moved to immeasurable gratitude. Moreover, we are called to share it with our love-starved world.

Even today, there are still many people who do not know that God exists, that he loves them, and that he came to bring freedom and peace through his life, death, and resurrection. Many unbelievers are waiting for someone to bring them hope. Missionaries are always needed to bring the Good News of salvation in Christ to the ends of the earth. Jesus said we must pray to the "Lord of the harvest to send out laborers" that is missionaries to make Jesus' name known and loved throughout the world (Mt 9:37).

God is calling men and women to become servants of His Word by calling others to repent from sin and turn towards a new life of spiritual abundance. He wants many to leave house and country and go off to foreign lands. It is a challenging vocation, I know this from personal experience, and I acknowledge it as a true gift as well.

I encourage you all to pray for vocations to missionary life, and for perseverance in their calling. Your sacrificial giving

is also important too! As a former missionary in the Mongolian desert, we were unable to buy a single grain of rice without the financial support of members of the same household of the faith living in Canada and the US. May God reward you for your generosity.






