The Pastor's Reflection

"Jesus, son of David, have pity on me." And many rebuked him, telling him to be silent." (Mk 10:47)

Dear brothers and sisters in Christ:

Jesus is on his way out of Jericho. Bartimeaus, a blind man, is begging. Mark tells us that Bartimeaus began calling out to Jesus as soon as he heard Christ was passing by. He cried out "Jesus, son of David, have pity on me." I cannot see. I am cut off from the others. I am isolated. I want to see everything around me. I especially want to see you! You would think that those who surrounded Bartimeaus would encourage him to ask for healing. Instead, they did the opposite.

These people were unlike the four friends who lowered their paralyzed companion down through the roof so that Jesus could heal him (cf. Mk 2:3-11). Those who surrounded Bartimeaus told him to be quiet. Can you imagine! He was being prevented from approaching the Lord.

Thankfully, Bartimeaus ignored them and started to yell even louder. This insistence caught the attention of Christ. He stops and tells the others to call him forward. The people go from telling him to be quiet, to get up and go to him. Then, Jesus asks him, "what do you want me to do for you?" (Mk 10:51) His response is simple and direct. Bartimeaus says "I want to see." That is exactly what Jesus does for him. He heals him of his blindness. Most importantly, he can see the face of Jesus Christ!

The people who tried to quiet Bartimeaus were not evil. They were decent people. They thought they were trying to protect Jesus' time. Perhaps they thought that Bartimeaus wasn't worthy of Jesus Christ's attention. My question is: Who is? It wasn't until Jesus himself intervened that they changed their attitude.

Some people wrongly believe they can decide who is worthy to approach the Lord. In the end, we throw up obstacles on their way. This leads us to becoming stumbling blocks to salvation. Yet, the very fact that they are making an effort to approach Christ reveals at least some awareness one's sinfulness and need of salvation. Many of us have been blind at some point along our spiritual journey. Most of us can identify with words in that timeless hymn, Amazing Grace. The author, John Newton, wrote, "Amazing grace, how sweet the sound, That saved a wretch like me! I once was lost, but now am found, Was blind, but now I see."




