The Pastor's Reflection

"The Lord has done great things for us and we are filled with joy." (Ps 126:1)

Dear brothers and sisters in Christ:

December 8th is a very special day for the Church. Traditionally, it is the day that we celebrate the Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception.

"The Immaculate Conception is a Catholic dogma that states that Mary, whose conception was brought about the normal way, was conceived without original sin or its stain. Our Lady is "immaculate", which means "without stain". It's important to for us to understand what the doctrine of the Immaculate Conception is, and what it is not. There are some people who think that the term refers to Christ's conception in Mary's womb without the intervention of a human father. This is a mistaken belief. Others think the Immaculate Conception means Mary was conceived "by the power of the Holy Spirit," in the same way as Jesus, this too is incorrect.

The essence of original sin consists in the deprivation of sanctifying grace, and its stain is a corrupt nature. Sanctifying grace is a supernatural gift from God that transforms a person's soul, enabling them to live and act in accordance with God's love. Mary was preserved from these defects by God's grace; from the first instant of her existence, she was in the state of sanctifying grace and was free from the corrupt human nature that original sin brings to humankind. When discussing the Immaculate Conception, an implicit reference may be found in the angel's greeting to Mary. The angel Gabriel said, "Hail, full of grace, the Lord is with you" (Luke 1:28). The phrase "full of grace" is a translation of the Greek word kecharitomene. The term full of grace expresses a characteristic quality of Mary.

The grace given to Mary is at once permanent and of a unique kind. Kecharitomene is a perfect passive participle of charitoo, a Greek word meaning "to fill or endow with grace." Since this term is in the perfect tense, it indicates that Mary was graced in the past and with continuing effects in the present. So, the grace Mary enjoyed was not a result of the angel's visit. In fact, Catholics hold, it extended over the whole of her life, from conception onward. She was in a state of sanctifying grace from the first moment of her existence." (Catholic Answers)

What is the greatest way to honour our beloved mother? First, say the following prayer often: "O Mary, conceived without sin, pray for us who have recourse to thee." Second, love the Lord and seek to make him known. Through baptism, we become partners "for the gospel." (Phil 1:4) The greatest gift you can share with your loved ones is Jesus Christ. Keep this gift in your mind and heart as you do your Christmas shopping!


