## **BAPTISM OF THE LORD**

"After the Lord was baptized, the heavens were opened, and the Spirit descended upon him like a dove, and the voice of the Father thundered: This is my beloved Son, with whom I am well pleased."

Dear brothers and sisters in Christ:

Merry Christmastide! This Sunday is the last day of the Christmas season, and we end it with the Baptism of Christ.

The Father sends the Spirit to his Son which empowers him for his public ministry. What does Jesus seek to accomplish? To make us children of God! In his book entitled, God as Father, Fernando Ocariz writes "The key to intimacy with the Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit is to follow Christ in such a way that we not only imitate but identify ourselves with him." Imagine that! We can become extra Christ's in today's world. All this is possible thanks to the Incarnation, and our baptism. Let us seek to please him by blessing the Lord at all times and living a life that makes us worthy of the name Christian.

So how can we please Christ? First, we need faith. Do we believe? Do I know he loves me? Does Christ know me in a general impersonal way, or in an intimate, loving and caring manner?
