

Weekly Biblical Reflection

Someone asked him, "Lord, will only a few be saved?" Jesus said to them, "Strive to enter through the narrow door; for many, I tell you, will try to enter and will not be able." (Lk 13:22-23)

Dear brothers and sisters in Christ:

Have you ever asked this question? Have you ever thought about your own salvation and that of others? Your family, friends, and even enemies? Perhaps too few of us do. Yet, it is an incredibly important question because it has to do with eternity.

Interestingly enough, Jesus doesn't give a direct answer. He redirects his attention, and ours, to the present. What we do here on earth determines what happens to us when we die. Contrary to what many believe, death is not the sole requirement to enter into heaven. This is NOT because God doesn't want us to be with him. Not at all!

Saint Catherine of Genoa explains it like this, "As for paradise, God has placed no doors there. Whoever wishes to enter, does so. All-merciful God stands there with His arms open, waiting to receive us into His glory. I also see, however, that the divine essence is so pure and light-filled...that the soul that has but the slightest imperfection would rather throw itself into a thousand hells than appear thus before the divine presence." This means that we need to seek and do the will of God daily in order to be purified of our selfishness on earth and become filled with his divine light through our participation in the sacraments and loving service towards our neighbour.

If we endure to the end (Mt 24:13), we shall then leap into the arms of the all-merciful God without hesitation.




2. Rite of Christian Initiation for Adults (RCIA):
