

Weekly Biblical Reflection

Dear brothers and sisters, we are approaching the end of our liturgical year, and the liturgy invites us to reflect on the end of time.

In today's Gospel, Jesus is talking about the fall of civilizations, wars and natural disasters, and persecutions, things we are unfortunately very familiar with in our time. Faced with all this distress, he invites us to trust that he will provide for us.

While surely this Gospel is about the end of time, I think that it is very valuable for our spiritual life. All of us have interior wars, interior famines, and earthquakes that often leave us confused and feeling lost. In those moments, it is very easy to despair; our interior fights often involve our feelings and thoughts, areas in which our enemy, the devil, often attacks us.

Jesus invites us to trust in him; he invites us not to follow ideologies and philosophies that promise us salvation without the struggle. The struggle is part of human existence, and Jesus calls us not to be afraid, because he is with us: "...not a hair of your head will perish." Because he is the one who has undergone the fight for us and has come out risen, victorious. In front of our daily wars and fears, he shows himself risen, willing to give us eternal life.


