THE BAPTISM OF THE LORD

"After the Lord was baptized, the heavens were opened, and the Spirit descended upon him like a dove, and the voice of the Father thundered: This is my beloved Son, with whom I am well pleased."
(Cf. Matthew 3.16-17)

Weekly Biblical Reflection

Brothers and Sisters, today we celebrate the feast of the Baptism of the Lord. It is a great feast that shows us the love and humility of God. In today's gospel passage, we see Jesus going to be baptized by John the Baptist. As we have heard during Advent, John the Baptist had been preaching a baptism of repentance from sins in order to be ready to welcome the coming Messiah; therefore, we can all understand his surprise at seeing Jesus coming to him to be baptized. John wants to refuse, but Jesus says, "Let it be so for now; for it is proper for us in this way to fulfill all righteousness."

Here we have Jesus, the Messiah, the Second Person of the Holy Trinity, incarnate, who is not ashamed to be in line with all kinds of sinners. We know that soldiers and tax collectors and all kinds of sinners were going to John, and in the midst of it all is Jesus. This is the humility, the love, and the freedom of God, who is not concerned with his own image, but in order to save us, he does not consider his likeness to God something to be grasped at, as St. Paul tells us in the letter to the Philippians.

God's love is free from self-interest, and this freedom means that God's love also comes in ways that we do not always understand or like at first. However, we are all called to listen to the voice of the Father who tells all of us, "This is my Son, the Beloved." Brothers and Sisters, let us look at him who loves us totally, and let us not be afraid of his action, but let us welcome him and trust him.


