# TWELFTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

*“The Lord is the strength of his people, a saving refuge for the one he has anointed. Save your people, Lord, and bless your heritage, and govern them for ever.”*

(Cf. Psalm 27.8-9)

## Weekly Biblical Reflection

*“So have no fear of them; for nothing is covered that will not be revealed, or hidden that will not be known.”*  
(Matthew 10:26).

When I was little, my parents would ask me to fetch things from the basement, even though I would rather have jumped out of a plane. Our basement was unfinished, dark, and the sounds I heard down there creeped me out. The only light source was a single bulb that turns on and off by pulling on a chain, and it was at the bottom of the stairs. Having retrieved whatever it was that my mom asked for, I would blindly race up the stairs, hearing someone at my heels trying to pull me back down into that place of nightmares. Sweating with heart racing, I would hand my mom the tablecloths she wanted, and think to myself: was that worth risking my life for?

In the face of the unknown, darkness can be scary. Meeting new people can be scary because I do not know what they will think of me; taking on a new project is daunting because I do not know how it will turn out; and finally, in trying to be a faithful disciple of Christ, I find it unnerving to place all my hopes on His promise of eternal life. What does that even look like, to be in Heaven forever? This is one of the reasons why I keep falling short of the high demands of discipleship: I settle for goods that I can see, so that I can avoid the anxiety of waiting for the Heaven that I cannot yet see.

Yet, there is much evidence to show that God does not leave us completely in the dark. Like a loving teacher, He guides us toward Heaven using things that we can see, like the sparrows in today's Gospel (Mt 10:29-31). Have you ever watched birds flying in the wind? How free they are, completely trusting something they cannot see: air. It is true that I cannot yet see God, and that the Face of Jesus lies hidden in the Eucharist, but am I not able to perceive that He still cares for me, and that He gives His Life for mine? Behold with me, then, during Mass, that blessed bread and wine; that subtle yet powerful presence in my life that gives flight to my wings. Yes, it may be dark now, and filled with frightful unknowns, but soon I will reach the light, and in that light I will see more clearly that I was never, not even for a single moment, left alone (cf. 1 Cor 13:12).


## Announcements

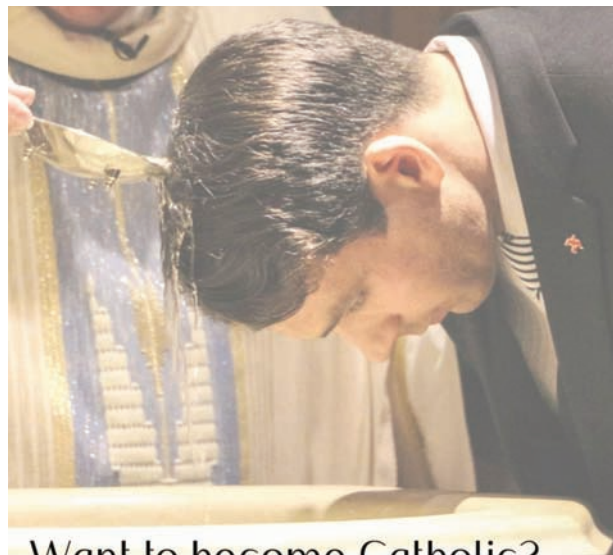

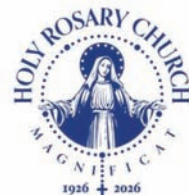
