Weekly Biblical Reflection

"Whoever welcomes you, welcomes me"

Some of you may know that I am not from Toronto. I grew up in a small city where life is quite different. People know their neighbours. Doors are rarely locked. If you want to see a friend, even after many years, you just show up unannounced. No text messages or appointments. You knock or more often just walk in, and you are welcomed.

Here in Toronto, things work differently. We schedule everything, protect our privacy, and our doors are always locked. I do understand why. The world can be complicated, and sometimes we need to be careful.

However, I wonder if, somewhere along the way, we have become so good at guarding ourselves that we've forgotten how much people need to feel welcomed.

Let's take a look at the woman of Shunem who sees Elisha passing by. He's a stranger, yet she makes room for him, offering a meal, a bed, and a lamp. Nothing extraordinary. Just simple hospitality. Yet through that simple act, God's grace enters her life.

Then Jesus tells us, "Whoever welcomes you welcomes me." He even says that offering a cup of cold water to someone in need is noticed by God.

A cup of water, a phone call, a short chat, or simple words of encouragement. If you think about it, these are really small things. Still, these are often the moments when Christ becomes visible.

Hospitality is not just about opening our homes. It's about opening our hearts. It's about helping someone feel seen, valued, and loved.

The Kingdom of God is built through those ordinary acts of welcome. When we make room for others, we often discover that we've made room for God as well.

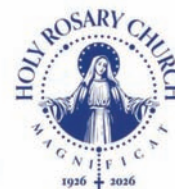
