## *Weekly Biblical Reflection*

*"Come to me all you who are weary, and I will give you rest." (Matthew 11:25)*

Dear brothers and sisters in Christ:

One of the most famous images of Jesus Christ associated with this consoling verse is that of the Sacred Heart. While looking at us, the Saviour points to his meek and humble heart that is always open and ready to receive us. We can experience these words in different ways depending on what is happening in our lives at the moment we read or hear them.

Just a few days ago, we returned from our pilgrimage to Italy and Medjugorje. Much of Europe was (and likely still is) undergoing an intense heat wave. It was unbearably hot and humid. This made the climb up Apparition Hill in Medjugorje even more difficult than normal. Moreover, the walks to each of the many shrines we visited left many of us feeling utterly exhausted.

However, everything changed at the Mass. No matter how tired or unwell some of us may have felt, we all experienced deep peace and rest in the Eucharist. The Lord's words in Scripture resonated so deeply with the experiences of each day. Then came the reception of Holy Communion. After receiving our Lord, we had an extended period of quiet thanksgiving prior to the final blessing. Weariness was replaced with quiet peace and rest.

Oftentimes, we can experience weariness and fatigue. Jesus is always there, pointing to himself. He reminds us that he and he alone can give us the rest that we all need in order to continue on this pilgrimage called life. Wherever you go this summer, please keep Sunday Mass central to all your plans. Moreover, find a chapel for extended periods of Adoration so you can become filled with Christ's presence and be a source of peace to those you will meet.

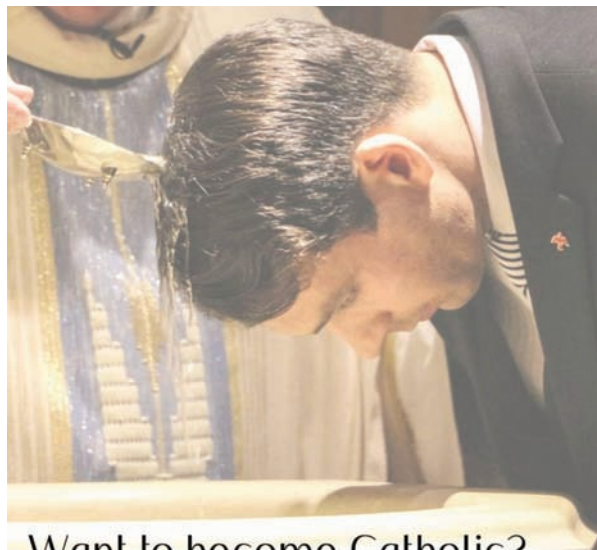

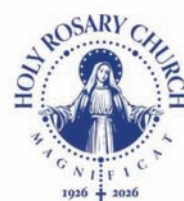
